

The Working Ranch Cowboys Association was formed in 1995 by 20 cowboys, ranchers and others devoted to preserving the heritage, ethics and lifestyle of the working ranch cowboy and to promote ranching nationally. The WRCA is best known for producing the World Championship Ranch Rodeo in Amarillo, TX each November. Each qualifying team will compete for the title of World Champion. WRCA Scholarship Fund helps to send sons, daughters and spouses of working ranch cowboys to college or vocational school. WRCF Cowboy Crisis Fund was established to help provide financial assistance to working ranch cowboys and their families that may be suffering significant hardships. RANCH RODEO EVENTS


RANCH BRONC RIDING-Cowboy rides for 8 seconds in a regular stock saddle. "Ride as ride can"

WILD COW MILKING-A 4 person team, with only the roper horseback, must rope and mug a cow, holding her long enough to get her milked into a bottle. The cow must be standing to be milked. The runner then has to bring the bottle to the finish line where a judge will pour out the milk.

TEAM BRANDING-A 4 or 5 person team, including a roper, 2 flankers, a brander and a herd holder. The roper must rope 2 calves and drag them to the "fire" to be branded with the help of the other team members.

SORT/DOCTOR~4-man team must sort a 3 head from the herd in numerical order and then head/heel the last yearling sorted. They must flank/mark the yearling as if it's been doctored.

STRAY GATHERING- A 4-man team, all horseback, will rope 2 head of yearlings that will be turned out. Each yearling must be headed, heeled and tied down.



TOP HAND CONTEST

There are 20+ ranch rodeos during the season. There is one cowboy that is named "Top Hand". This is an elite group of cowboys that will be competing in Hugo for the title to Top Hand Champion. The invited cowboys will be competing in events such as Single Man Penning, Dally Calf Roping and Trailer Loading. Each of these events is done individually, not as a team, increasing the difficulty. ~Sponsored by Bledsoe Ranch~
